The Lyceum was established in **1994** for students from disadvantaged backgrounds to achieve a **high quality** education free of charge financed by the **british fund** of Khodorkovsky. Today, the Lyceum is home to 200 students aged 10- 18. The school offers a wide raging **curriculum** and encourages students to take part in **extracurricular** activities such as sports, art and music. The school is situated in the stunning **Korallovo forest**, 40 km outside of Moscow.

THE PROGRAM OF VOLUNTEERS ATENDANCE AND PERFORMANCE AT LYCEUM PODMOSCOVNY



1. Giving a speech at the school's assembly with a presentation about your country, hometown and yourself. (On the first Thursday after arriving)

2. Assisting the teachers in 2 - 4 English lessons per day (8:20 - 14:00)
